The organizers of the SCRIN Summit invite you to submit an abstract by October 4, 2024. Selected abstracts will be presented on the Scientific Day of the Summit, and their extended versions may be submitted as articles at a special session or workshop at DCAI 2025, depending on the abstract's content and focus.

Brief Description & Info

- **Aims & Scope:** The aim is to present original research, case studies, technological developments, and recent advancements in cybersecurity applied to the Internet of Things (IoT). Abstracts should focus on innovative methods, technologies, and approaches addressing security challenges in IoT devices, networks, and infrastructures. We seek to foster knowledge exchange on protecting these systems against cyberattacks, ensuring their robustness and resilience. Contributions should support the development of practical and effective solutions to enhance security in the IoT domain. We invite research contributions covering various aspects, including (but not limited to):
 - Cybersecurity Frameworks for IoT
 - Cyberattack Simulation and Modeling
 - Artificial Intelligence in IoT Cybersecurity
 - Security in Critical Infrastructures
 - Resilience and Recovery from Cyberattacks
 - Cybersecurity in Industrial IoT (IIoT)
 - Cybersecurity in Specific Applications
 - Blockchain and Cybersecurity: Protection against Threats and Vulnerabilities

- **Title**
- **Rationale**
- **Objectives**
- **Conclusion**
- **Keywords**

Important Points:

1. Abstracts must be written in English.
2. They must present new or recent scientific results.
3. The same abstract cannot be submitted by different registrants.

Review Process:

- Peer review

FAQ for Call for Abstracts

- **Is there a cost for submission?**
There is no cost for submission or attending the summit.
- **Does the submitter need to be registered for the Summit?**
Registration is required to submit an abstract. If your abstract is selected, attending the summit to present your abstract is mandatory. If your abstract is not selected, attendance is optional, though registration remains required.
- **Are multiple abstracts permitted to be submitted?**
Yes, multiple abstracts are permitted.
- **Does the presenting author have to be the first author?**
No, the presenting author does not need to be the first author.
- **Can the presenting author act as a presenter for multiple abstracts?**
The presenting author can present multiple different abstracts.
